

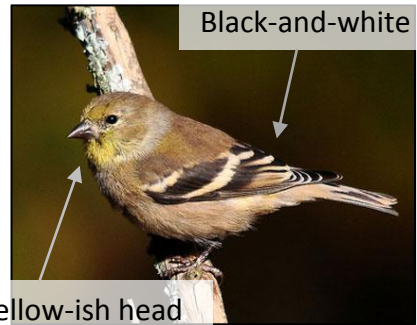

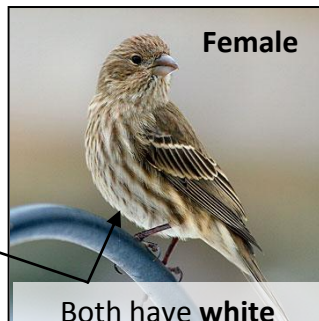
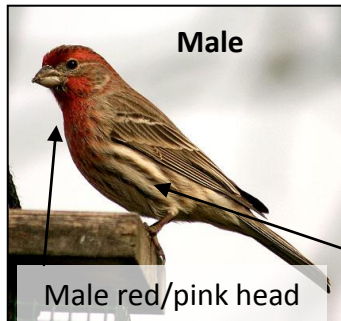
Northern Cardinal



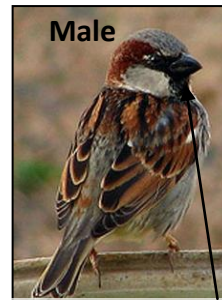

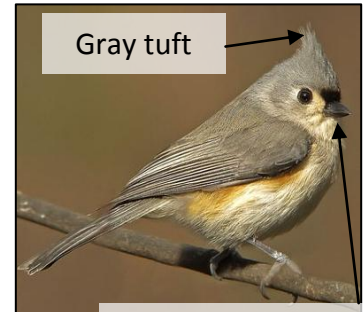

Blue-Jay




Downy Woodpecker

Hairy Woodpecker




Long beak

Yellow beak, tiny white spots
May have rainbow shine


American Robin



May be less red in winter

Purple Finch

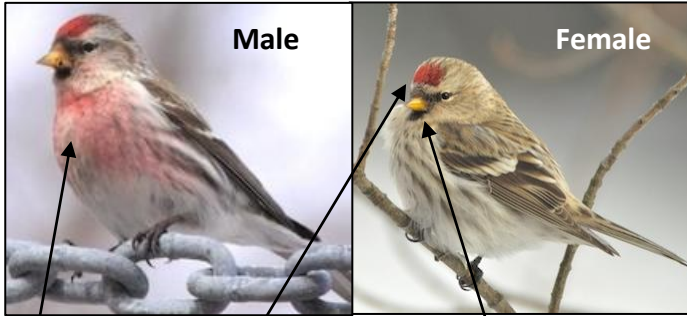


Slightly pink all over, (no streaks on belly like house finch)

Common Redpoll



Male has pink on belly, both have black mask and clear red-brown patch (house finch has neither)

American Tree Sparrow



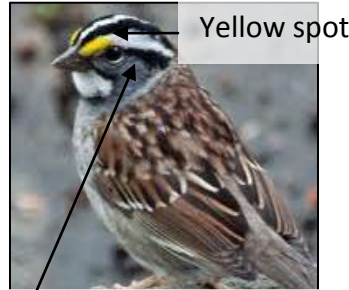
Like house sparrow with rust-colored hood and stripe

Song Sparrow



Head, back, and belly covered in brown streaks (house finch has gray)

White-throated Sparrow



Clear black and white (or tan) head stripes

Cedar Waxwing

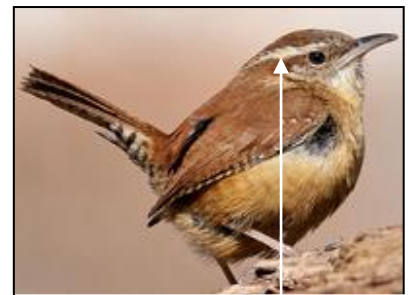


Eastern Bluebird



Red-brown and white on belly, blue to blue-gray on head and wings

Carolina Wren



Light eyebrow, tail often up
